School: Fern Creek High School

Subject of the Policy: Curriculum: Determination of the schedule day and week.

Policy Statement

The Fern Creek High School class schedule will reflect a Hybrid Six Period Schedule. The Hybrid Six Period Schedule will move all core curriculum classes, all Advanced Placement courses, and identified elective and career pathway courses to two semesters. The remaining elective and career pathway courses will be one to two trimester courses based on the standards of the course. Each teacher is assigned a maximum of five teaching periods per day, and a planning period. Each school day will have six periods meeting 58 instructional minutes each.

The length of the school year and school calendar are determined by Jefferson County Public Schools. Students are assigned classes based on the graduation requirements set by the local Board of Education. Student select classes during open scheduling, under direction of the assigned counselor.

The six period day follows the following schedule:
